ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR ADVANCE COURSE IN MOUNTAINEERING & ALLIED SPORTS [ACMAS]

Online Entrance Examination (OEE)

Online Applications are invited from all eligible candidates for admission to Advance Course in Mountaineering & Allied Sports [ACMAS] course offered by the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Department of Sports & Physical Education with Guardian Giripremi Institute of Mountaineering, Pune.

1) Entrance Examination & Admission:

- Candidate shall be admitted to the above course strictly on the basis on the merit in the Entrance Examination.
- Syllabus for the Entrance Examination of course will be available on the webpage of the Department.
- The Online Entrance Examination (OEE) will be of 100 marks with multiple choice questions (MCQ).
- The Entrance Examination will be conducted by the Department which runs the course.
- The Online Entrance Exam Paper will consist of 2 sections

a) Section-A General Knowledge / Aptitude / Logic / Comprehension / as per the syllabus:

20 marks

b) Section-B Subject Specific Questions as per the syllabus :

80 marks

Examination of both the sections will be conducted together.

- Negative marking system will be applied for evaluation wherever relevant. For every wrong answer ¼ (one fourth) of the allotted marks of the question will be deducted.
- Merit list of the candidates based on total score of Section A and B would be prepared for the admission.
- In case of candidates securing equal marks in the OEE, merit list would be prepared based on marks secured in Section B of the OEE.
- In case of candidates securing equal marks in Section B of OEE as well, merit list would be prepared based total a subject specific secured in the qualifying examination.
- Admission for various Advance Courses shall be done as per the provision of Ordinance 181-A amended, University Order. (Circular No. PGS/1821, dated 14/06/2019).

3) Courses & Eligibility:

4) Reservation:

Reservation in admission of students to Advance (Diploma) course shall be as per the norms laid down by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time including reservation for the person with Divyanga / Orphan and Defence Personnel's Child / Ex-Serviceman Child.

5) Processing Fees and Mode of Payment:

Following fee is applicable for application of a single course :

a) For candidates belonging to General Category : Rs. 800/-

b) For candidates belonging to Reserved Categories : Rs. 600/-

Payment should be made online using Debit / credit Card / Net Banking etc.

6) Instructions for Filling Online Application:

Online application form is available on the website: https://campus.unipune.ac.in/CCEP/Login.aspx

Required Documents: Candidate shall upload the following documents with the application:

- a) Photo-copy of the statement of marks of the qualifying examination passed, if applicable (which is required for the eligibility).
- b) Photo-copy of the caste certificate issued by the Government of Maharashtra in case of Reserved category candidates (if applicable).
 - As per Government of Maharashtra rules, reserved category students belonging to state other than Maharashtra (other state) are treated as Open (General) category.
- c) Photo-copy of a valid Non-Creamy Layer certificate issued by the Government of Maharashtra in case of Reserved category (OBC/DTNT/SBC/Women) candidates (if applicable). Photo-copy of certificate issued by Government of Maharashtra in case of EWS student.
- Candidates are NOT required to submit print out of application / documents to the University after online submission of application. However, these documents in original have to be submitted to the respective Department at the time of admission.
- Incomplete applications / applications without uploading required documents / applications submitted after the last date will be rejected without assigning any reason and no correspondence will be entertained by the University in this regard.
- No request for change in any information provided in the online form will be entertained by the University.

7) General Instructions:

- Securing place in the Merit List does not automatically guarantee admission to the course. The admission is confirmed only upon the submission of all the required and valid documents to the Department and fulfilling of eligibility criteria.
- University reserves right to admit candidates without entrance examination if number of applications are less than the intake capacity.
- In case of any grievance or disputes, the decision of the admission committee shall be final and abiding.
- Admission to any program does not guarantee Hostel facility or any kind of financial support in any form like Scholarship, Fellowship, Earn & Learn etc.
- It is the responsibilities of the applicant to fulfil the eligibility conditions and comply with the admission requirements. If at any stage, it is noticed that a false claim has been made by the candidate or important facts have been concealed and / or the candidate is not eligible, his/her candidature shall be liable for cancellation at any stage.

Online registration process will be treated as complete only after the required certificates and applications are uploaded on https://campus.unipune.ac.in/CCEP/Login.aspx on or before 19/07/2025.
