

FAQs - Advance Course (Diploma) in Mountaineering & Allied Sports

- Does this course cover Basic Mountaineering Course from national institutes? - **No. It doesn't cover BMC however, the syllabus covers comprehensive skills, knowledge of rock, snow, ice, and glaciers.**
- What is the duration of practical training - **The Sahyadri Practical training will occur in Pune and The Himalaya training in the Northern states. Sahyadri training will be of 10 while Himalaya training will be of 15 days.**
- Can I pay the course fees in installments? - **No. You have to pay the entire fees at once. In case you need a financial assistance, you can get in touch with us - admin@ggim.in. GGIM would assess your application for financial assistance and respond you accordingly.**
- Can I apply for the course if I'm below 18 or above 60 years of age? - **No**
- Can I skip theory lectures and only attend practical and exams? - **No. You need to have min 75% attendance to qualify to appear for the end semester exams.**
- How should participants from outside Pune enroll for the course? Are there any hostel, mess which students can join? If it is not possible to relocate to Pune, still is there any way to enroll in course? - **No hostel facility by University. However, please contact GGIM team for further details. Theory lectures are online so you can attend practically from anywhere. You will have to attend practical training and end semester exams in person however.**
- Are there any scholarship options? - **Yes, please contact GGIM team for details - admin@ggim.in**
- Are there any other expenses than the tuition fees? -
Application fee: Rs.800 ; (Rs. 600 for reserved categories)
University library fee approx: Around Rs.3,000
Exam Fees approximately Rs.1,000 per semester and food and lodging during exam days
Travel arrangements till the practical training reporting point
- Are theory lectures be recorded and made available later? - **No**
- What are the measures being taken from safety point of view? trainers? equipment/ first aid/ Insurance? - **All Instructors are well qualified and the Equipment used during practical sessions is UIAA Certified and Personal Accidental Insurance is covered.**
- What about practical sessions and fees structure if lockdown imposed / extended like last year? - **As of now, there is no fixed policy decided. It will be finalized if such situation arises.**
- Is travelling cost for practical sessions included in fees? - **No, the travel cost is not included however lodging, boarding during the practical training days is included.**
- Is the cost for food during Sahyadri outdoor sessions covered? - **Yes**
